

VALENCIA GP CIRCUIT – MON 19 TO WED 21 FEBRUARY 2018

Valencia is a long-standing MotoGP circuit located near the coast in the southeast corner of Spain – so the winter weather tends to be warm and dry – hence the last GP of the year is always in Valencia! It's a great track to ride and it benefits from 2 important differences as compared to most other circuits... Firstly, it doesn't eat tyres, which saves you literally hundreds of Pounds as compared to other circuits in Spain! And secondly, Valencia's left-handed layout makes it unusual and interesting to ride.



Average weather conditions in Feb are predominantly sunny & bright with an average of 6 hours of sunshine per day. And February is one of the driest months with average rainfall similar to May. Only June, July & August are drier – but it's a bit too hot to wear leathers down there in the height of summer! Temperatures in Feb are ideal for track days too – on average it's a very comfortable 16 degrees during the day, which is ideal for riding bikes, or for strolling round the city checking out the amazing architecture! And with lots of direct flights from the UK to Valencia, getting there is easy too!

TRACKDAYS, BIKE TRANSPORT & HOTEL: £749 IF BOOKED BY 15 DEC (£799 thereafter).

This is based on 2 riders sharing a room and includes 3 days on circuit, bike transport from our main transport depot at Sandy in Bedfordshire and 3 nights room & breakfast in a 3 star city-centre hotel.

Single rooms are available (see below) and non-riders are welcome – the only cost for non-riders is the hotel.

TRACKDAYS & BIKE TRANSPORT: £699 IF BOOKED BY 15 DEC (£749 thereafter).

This includes 3 track days & bike transport from the main depot at Sandy in Bedfordshire. Hotel is not included.

BIKE HIRE INSTEAD OF BIKE TRANSPORT: FROM £1050 EXTRA

Bikes are the latest BMW S1000RR with tyres included. A damage deposit is required – this can be pre-authorised on a debit/credit card a few days before the event. Please see the bike hire page on our website for full details.

TRACKDAYS ONLY: 3 DAYS £500

Timekeeping service and garage space is included (subject to fair & equal use by all riders).

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OPTIONAL EXTRAS

4 star hotel single occupancy surcharge: £20 per night

4 star hotel extra nights & non-riders: £35ppn for 2 sharing a room, or £55pn for single occupancy

FLIGHTS

We do not sell flights so you need to book them yourself. **Book your flights early** to get the best prices. Easyjet & Ryanair offer flights from various UK airports to Valencia, or you can fly from the UK to Alicante or Murcia instead.

CIRCUIT INFO

If you follow MotoGP or World Superbikes you'll have seen this circuit many times – 4km long, 12m wide, 876m main straight and 14 turns (9 left & 5 right). And importantly, Valencia is very easy on tyres – and compared with other circuits in Spain, that saves you £100's!!!. TIMEKEEPING SERVICE

A timekeeping service will be provided for all riders. Everyone will be provided with a transponder free of charge, and live lap times will be available to view all day every day free of charge.

A dedicated timekeeper will administer this service, continuously monitoring lap times, and where appropriate rider groups will be adjusted according to lap times (for example, slower riders in the fast group will be moved to a group that is more comfortable for them, and vice-versa).

BOOKINGS, PAYMENTS, TERMS & CONDITIONS

A non-refundable/transferrable deposit of £199 is required at the time of booking and the non-refundable/transferrable final payment is due 1 month before the event. A non-refundable extra charge of 1.5% applies for payments by credit card (no charge for debit card payments). Our standard terms & conditions apply – please see our website for details.

COMPULSORY MEDICAL INSURANCE

Medical insurance is compulsory for all track days (with any organiser) in Spain. Standard travel insurance does not cover track days, but suitable insurance is available cheaply for UK residents – either as a single event policy (typically approx. £40-60 for up to 5 days), or as an annual policy (typically approx. £150-200 per year). Non UK residents can buy suitable insurance for approx. £20 per day (or approx. £25 per day including repatriation cover). Insurance details & contacts are provided as part of your booking confirmation, and again as part of your final instructions.
