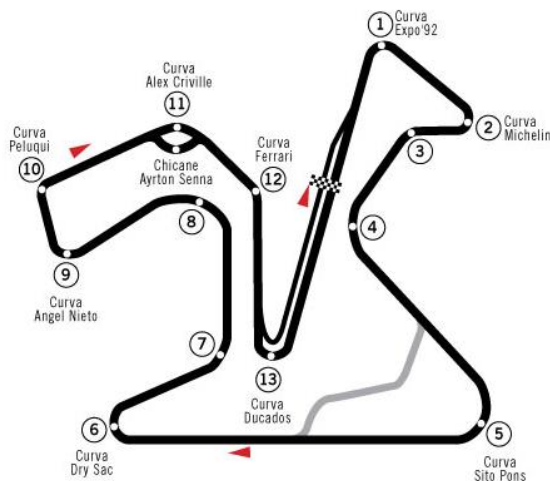
CIRCUIT INFO:

Jerez Grand Prix Circuit is situated 60 miles south of Seville near the historic port of Cadiz in southern Spain.

Originally built in 1986 for the Spanish round of the F1 Grand Prix championship, this circuit is a fascinating blend of fast & medium speed turns, which has become one of the all-time favourite circuits for motorcycle racing and track days alike. Although F1 did return to Jerez in 1994 & 1997, the circuit is now better known for hosting a variety of major world championship events such as MotoGP and the international GT series for cars.

Jerez is also widely used as a premier test track for many major motorsport teams including Formula 1.

The surface at Jerez is grippy and smooth, and as you would expect from a premier world-class venue, safety is the priority and the on-site medical facilities are superb. As part of a massive refurbishment programme in 2002, the entire circuit including the track, paddocks, garages, hospitality suites, grandstands, offices, etc. were all completely rebuilt from the ground up to a very high standard – hence Circuito de Jerez now stands as one of the premier venues in Spain.



TECHNICAL DETAILS

Circuit length 4.42km, start/finish straight 600 metres, circuit width 11 to 12 metres, 13 corners (8 right & 5 left), minimum corner radius 30 metres, maximum corner radius 116 metres, maximum gradient 5%.

TRACKDAYS, BIKE TRANSPORT & HOTEL: £829 IF BOOKED BY 30 SEPT (£879 thereafter)

This is based on 2 riders sharing a room and includes 3 track days, bike transport from the main depot at Sandy (Beds.) and 3 nights room & breakfast at a 4 star hotel near the circuit.

Single rooms are available and non-riders are welcome – see optional extras below for details.

TRACKDAYS & BIKE TRANSPORT: £724 IF BOOKED BY 30 SEPT (£774 thereafter)

This includes 3 track days and bike transport from the main depot at Sandy (Beds.).

BIKE HIRE INSTEAD OF BIKE TRANSPORT: £1050 EXTRA

Bikes are the latest S1000RR, GSXR1000 or R1 with tyres included. A £3800 damage deposit is required – this can be pre-authorized on a debit/credit card a few days before the event. See the bike hire page on our website for details.

TRACKDAYS ONLY: £525

This includes 3 track days only. Timekeeping and garage space is included (subject to fair & equal use by all riders).

OPTIONAL EXTRAS:

4 star hotel – single occupancy room surcharge: £25 per night.

4 star hotel – extra nights & non-riders: £45ppn for 2 sharing a room, or £70pn for single occupancy.

BOOKINGS, PAYMENTS, TERMS & CONDITIONS: A non-refundable/transferable deposit of £199 is required at the time of booking. The final balance is due 1 month before the event.
